If cast, there is a \$225 Production Fee for participation in Hairspray- (scholarships are available, please do not be swayed from auditioning due to financial strain!!!!)

Students who are cast in Hairspray are expected to conform to a standard of behavior that will reflect positively on themselves, their fellow cast members, their families, and their school. Please read ALL of the following and, following your conscience, sign if you agree to these standards.

- Cast members are not allowed to smoke, vape, use alcohol or illegal drugs while in rehearsals, performances, cast parties, or any activity representing the Summer Musical. Violations will result in removal from the cast.
- Cast members will refrain from using profanity in rehearsals, performances, or anything representing the Musical.
- Cast members will refrain from excessive displays of “show-mance” behaviors in rehearsals, performances, cast parties, or any activity representing the Summer Musical.
- Cast members who drive will not take other students off campus unless given permission by the parent of the student.
- Cast members will try to follow the edict of Mr. Spock who said “the needs of the many outweigh the needs of the few” and behave in a selfless manner whenever possible. While individual needs will be met whenever possible, the cast as a whole will remain the important entity.
- Cast members will respect the property of others. Do not borrow without permission.
- Cast members will attend all rehearsals on time, Excessive absences or tardies (not detailed on original conflict sheet) can jeopardize your spot in this show, or in the scene we are working on that day. Please do not plan trips (unless on the conflict sheet – which is taken into consideration when casting!) after the cast list is posted!
- Cast members are expected to attend rehearsals in “rehearsal attire,” which means clothing you can move in with no images or writing, no jeans or overly baggy clothing. We prefer adherence to LCS dress code. You may wear leggings/tights/unitard/leotard as long as you have a cover up such as shorts or a dance skirt. Rehearsal attire includes appropriate footwear: tennis/jazz/character shoes. Do not wear sandals or flip flops. Please no underwear as outerwear.

- Parents and cast are needed at the parent meeting in the Leon Chorus Room on February 4th at 6pm.
- Parents are asked to support their student by arranging transportation as needed; making sure students are taking care of themselves (especially as we approach “show week”) and participating in the parent support committees.

All conflicts should be registered with the student as they complete the online registration. Please note that our first blocking rehearsal is ON MEMORIAL DAY, and we have music rehearsals earlier in May. Please just put conflicts on the conflict form.
- Please do not use participation in this show as “behavioral leverage.” If participation in this show are dependent upon outside factors, please do not allow your student to audition. We begin making costumes as soon as the show is cast, and it is a great inconvenience to reassign voice parts, solos, and redo handmade costumes. **Please confer with all parental units who may have control over the student’s participation.**
